

Cookie Policy

1. Introduction

This Cookie Policy explains how **Ceannas House Inc.** ("Ceannas House," "we," "our," or "us") uses cookies and similar technologies when you visit www.ceannashouse.org (the "Website").

This Cookie Policy should be read together with our Privacy Policy, which explains how we collect, use, and protect personal information.

2. What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your computer, tablet, or mobile device when you visit a website.

Cookies allow websites to:

- Remember your preferences
- Improve website performance
- Recognize returning visitors
- Enhance security
- Measure website traffic
- Support website functionality

Cookies do not normally contain information that directly identifies an individual, although information associated with cookies may become linked to personal information that you voluntarily provide.

3. Types of Cookies We Use

Depending on how our Website operates, we may use the following categories of cookies.

Essential Cookies

These cookies are necessary for the Website to function properly.

They help with functions such as:

- Website security
- Session management
- Form submission
- Page navigation
- Fraud prevention

Because these cookies are necessary for the operation of the Website, they cannot normally be disabled through our systems.

Performance and Analytics Cookies

These cookies help us understand how visitors use our Website by collecting information such as:

- Pages viewed
- Time spent on pages
- Navigation patterns
- Device type
- Browser type
- Referral sources
- General geographic region

This information is collected in aggregate form whenever possible and is used to improve our Website and services.

Functionality Cookies

Functionality cookies remember choices you make, including:

- Language preferences
- Accessibility settings
- Previously entered information
- User preferences

These cookies help improve your experience during future visits.

Donation and Transaction Cookies

If you choose to make a donation through our Website, certain cookies may be used by our payment processing providers to:

- Maintain secure payment sessions
- Prevent fraud
- Verify transactions
- Improve payment reliability

Ceannas House does not store your complete payment card information.

Email and Campaign Cookies

If you subscribe to our newsletter or respond to an email campaign, cookies may help us understand:

- Whether emails were opened
- Which links were selected
- General engagement with communications

This information helps us improve future communications and better understand supporter interests.

4. Third-Party Cookies

Some cookies may be placed by trusted third-party service providers that assist us in operating the Website.

Depending on the services we use, these providers may include:

- Website hosting providers
- Website analytics providers
- Donation processing platforms
- Email marketing providers

- Embedded media providers
- Security providers

These third parties maintain their own privacy and cookie practices.

We encourage users to review the privacy policies of any third-party services they interact with.

5. How Long Cookies Remain on Your Device

Cookies generally fall into two categories.

Session Cookies

Session cookies are temporary and are deleted automatically when you close your browser.

Persistent Cookies

Persistent cookies remain on your device until:

- They expire automatically;
- You delete them; or
- Your browser removes them.

The duration varies depending on the purpose of each cookie.

6. Managing Cookies

Most web browsers allow you to:

- View stored cookies
- Delete cookies
- Block certain cookies
- Block all cookies

- Receive notifications before cookies are stored

Please note that disabling cookies may affect the functionality of portions of the Website, including donation forms, newsletters, and other interactive features.

Instructions for managing cookies can usually be found within your browser's Help or Settings menu.

7. Do Not Track Signals

Some internet browsers transmit "Do Not Track" ("DNT") signals.

Because there is currently no universally accepted standard governing DNT responses, Ceannas House does not currently respond differently to such signals.

If industry standards change, we may update our practices accordingly.
